Brief Report	<p>It is in this spirit that MIET organized one day sanitary pad distribution programme. It was organized by Dr. Garima Shrivastava at Shri Tara Chand School, Piyawali Tejpur, Dadri, Greater Noida. Dr. Garima Shrivastava spoke about the necessity and importance of using sanitary napkins among young girls.</p> <p>Sanitary napkins are used by women during their menstrual cycle. They ensure hygiene, comfort and confidence in women. They are a great boon to women as it assists them during their cycle. Only about 12% of menstruating women in India use sanitary pads. The rest use unhygienic material such as cloth, leaves and other material which is hazardous to their health.</p> <p>Sanitary pads were gifted to about 150 girls of school. 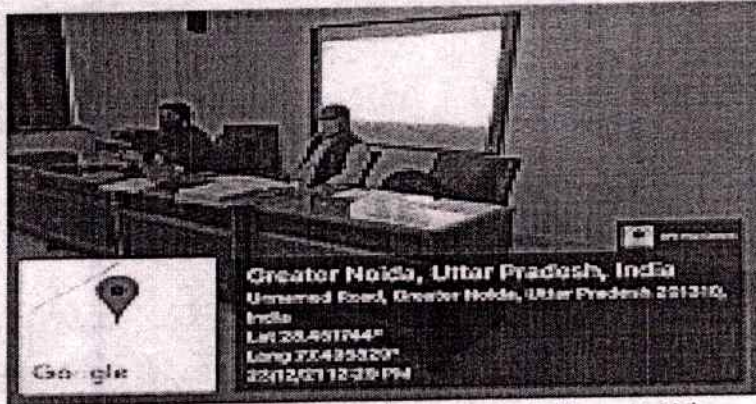


Figure 1 Mr. Abhishek Tiwari (Voter ID Card Officer , Noida)

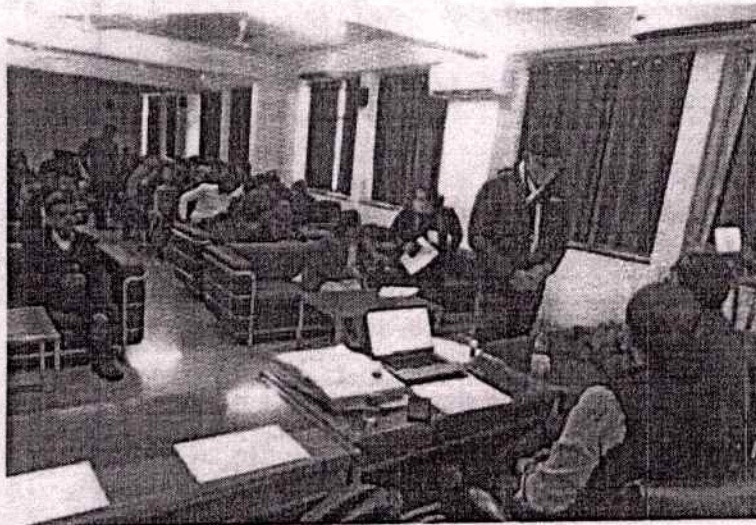




Figure 2 Students 18 & 18+ years & Mr. Abhishek Tiwari (Voter ID Card Officer , Noida) in Seminar Hall Block A
