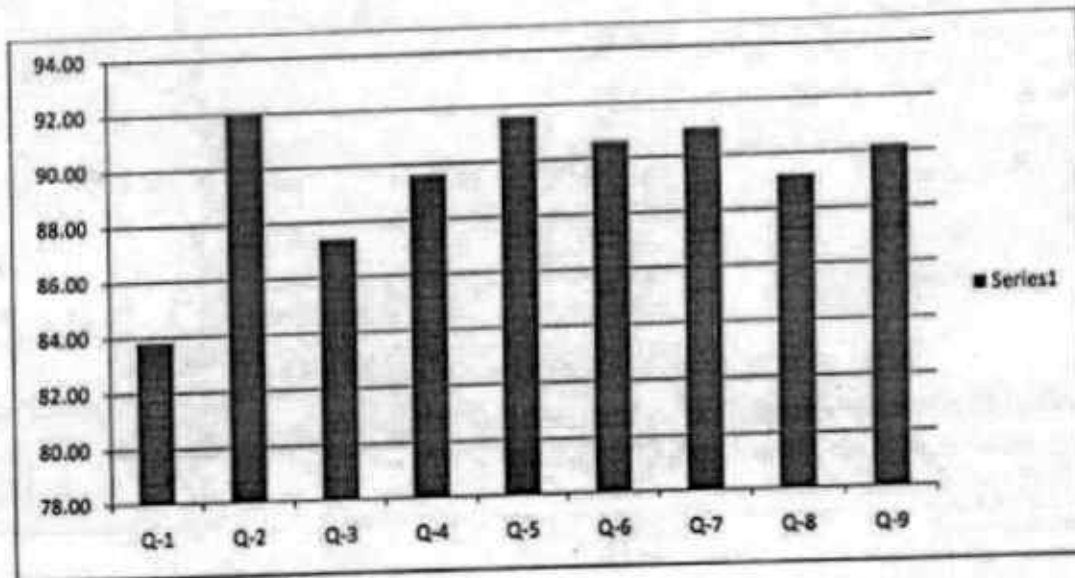

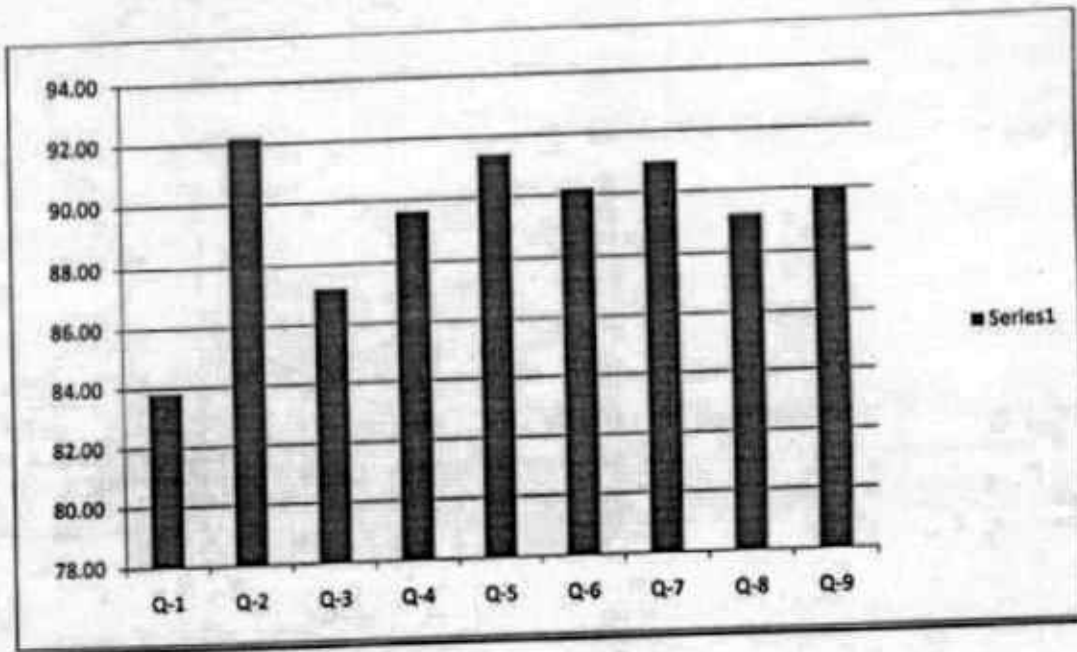

Action Taken on the basis of above Analysis Outcome 21-22

In light of the aforementioned analysis results, we initiated a procedure to assess the contentment of our faculty with the curriculum. 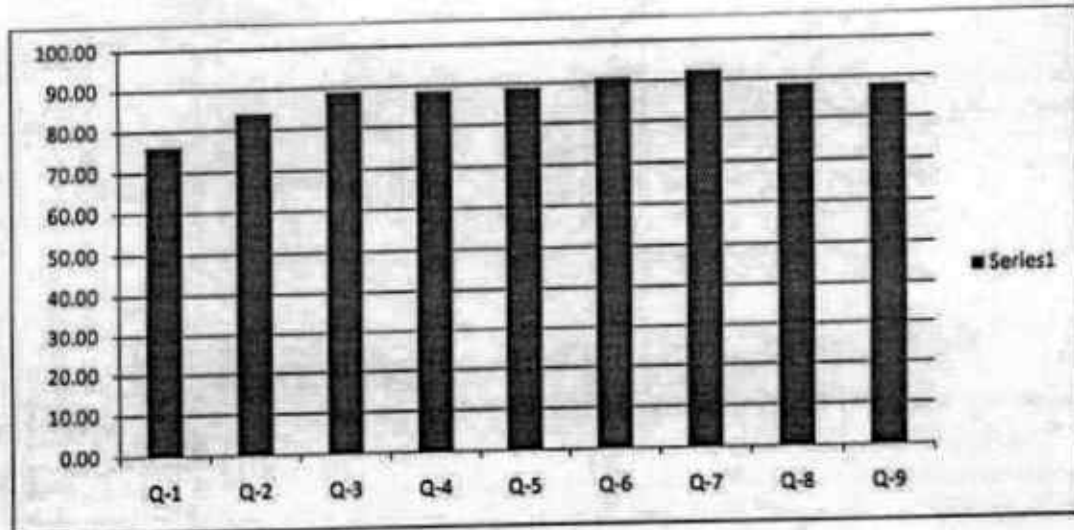

Action Taken on the basis of above Analysis Outcome 20-21


In response to the above analysis findings, we initiated a process to evaluate faculty satisfaction with the curriculum. Faculty members were asked to share their thoughts on the curriculum, and their feedback was collected and thoroughly analyzed. This analysis takes into account both their feedback and the proposed actions for improvement.

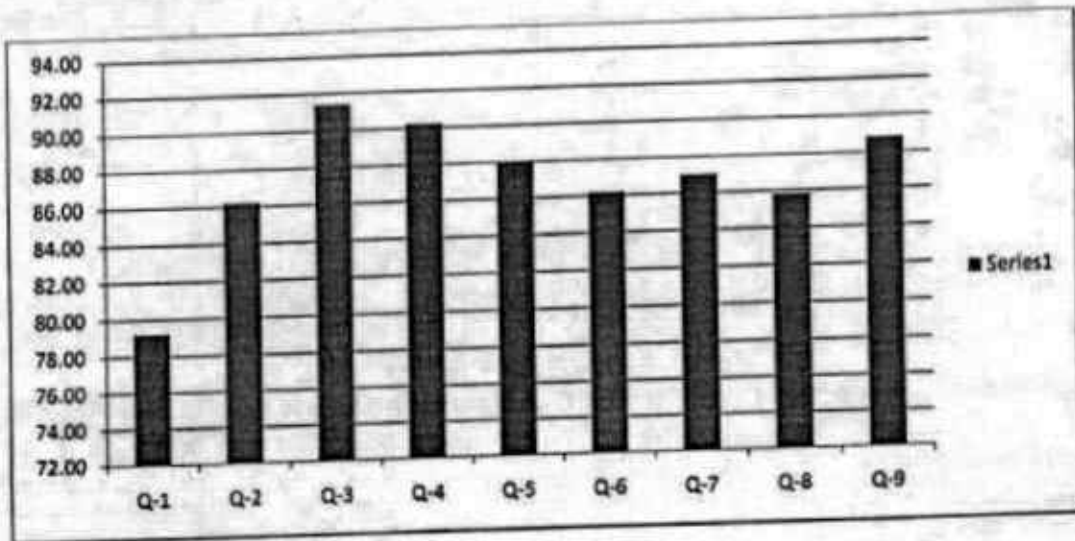
Upon analyzing the feedback forms, it is evident that all faculty members expressed satisfaction with the questions designed to gauge their opinions. Notably, the majority of questions received approval rates exceeding 85%, with the exception of question number 1, "Rate Your Program in Terms of Curriculum," which had a satisfaction rate of 76.20%, and Question-2, which garnered a satisfaction rate of 84%, rating the quality and relevance of the course in the program.

Since the design of the course and curriculum is determined by the affiliating university, AKTU, the institute has limited flexibility to make direct amendments. Therefore, we will be engaging with faculty members to collaborate on modifying their teaching methods and approaches to enhance overall satisfaction levels."
