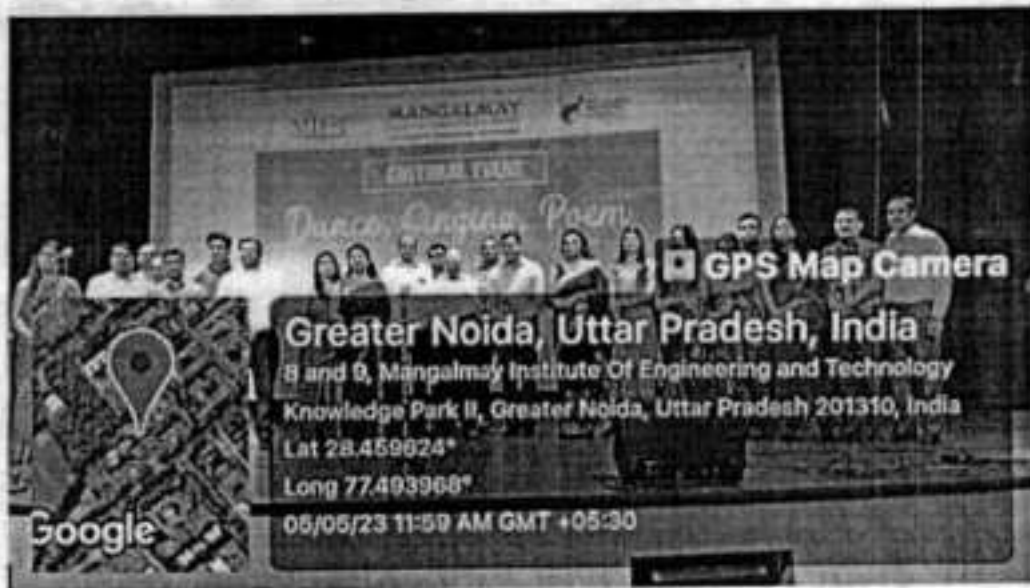

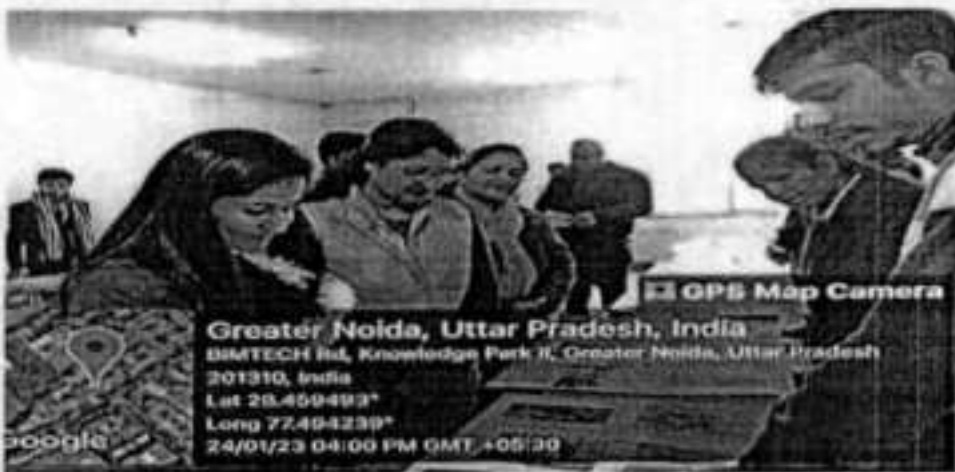

Name of the Event: Tug of War (Boys & Girls)

MIET-Sports club organized Tug-of-war competition for boys and girls under track events on 16th & 17th December 2022 in Mangalmay Institute of Engineering and Technology. In this competition, two participant's team at opposite ends of a rope, each team trying to drag the other across a centre line. In some forms of the game a tape or handkerchief is tied around the centre of the rope and two others are tied six feet (1.8 m) on either side. Three corresponding lines are marked on the ground. The competition ends when one participant's team pulls the other so that the tape on the losers' side crosses the ground mark on the winners' side. The contest is decided by the best two out of three pulls.

The rules of the event were as follows:

1. Each team in a Tug of War competition consists of eight people.
2. There are various weight classifications in Tug of War, and the mass of the eight people combined must not weigh more than that determined by the category that they are placed in.
3. The rope used should be of a circumference of approximately 11 cm and should be marked in the middle with a centre line as well as two marks that should be placed 4m from the centre line.
4. At the start of the pull, the centre line of the rope should be immediately above line marked on the ground.
5. Both teams pull the rope, the winner being the team who manage to pull the mark on the rope closest to their opponents over the centre line.
6. The rope must be pulled underarm and nobody's elbow must go below the knee, otherwise a foul will be called.
7. Matches are often a best of three pull, the winner winning two out of the three pulls.

Raider One who enters into the court of the opponent with the cant is known as a 'RAIDER'. The raider must begin his cant before he touches the opponent's court. Anti or Anti-Raider every player in whose court the raid is being made shall be called Anti or Anti Raider. Loosing the Cant To stop the repeated and clear aloud sounding of the word

KABADDI' or take in a breath during cant by the raider is known as loosing the cant. A cant must be continued within one and the same respiration.


To put out an anti If a raider touches an anti without the breach of rules of play or if any part of the body of an anti touches any part of the body of the raider and then the raider touches his court with the cant, the anti is said to be put out.

To Hold a Raider If the anti or antis hold the raider without breach of rules of play and keep the raider in their court and do not allow him to reach his court until he looses his cant or the Referee/Umpire blows the whistle, is known as holding the raider.

Raid When the raider enters the court of opponent with cant, it is known as Raid.

Successful Raid When the raider crosses the Baulk line of the defending team at least once during the course of a raid and reaches his court with cant, it is known as Successful Raid.

Name of the Event: Tug of War (Boys & Girls)


In the theme of AZADI KA AMRIT MAHOTSAV our sports club organized Tug-of-war competition for boys and girls on 13th –14th January, 2022 in Mangalmay Institute of Engineering and Technology. In this competition, two participant's team at opposite ends of a rope, each team trying to drag the other across a centre line. In some forms of the game a tape or handkerchief is tied around the centre of the rope and two others are tied six feet (1.8 m) on either side. Three corresponding lines are marked on the ground. The competition ends when one participant's team pulls the other so that the tape on the losers' side crosses the ground mark on the winners' side. The contest is decided by the best two out of three pulls.

The rules of the event were as follows:

1. Each team in a Tug of War competition consists of eight people.
2. There are various weight classifications in Tug of War, and the mass of the eight people combined must not weigh more than that determined by the category that they are placed in.
3. The rope used should be of a circumference of approximately 11 cm and should be marked in the middle with a centre line as well as two marks that should be placed 4m from the centre line.
4. At the start of the pull, the centre line of the rope should be immediately above line marked on the ground.
5. Both teams pull the rope, the winner being the team who manage to pull the mark on the rope closest to their opponents over the centre line.
6. The rope must be pulled underarm and nobody's elbow must go below the knee, otherwise a foul will be called.
7. Matches are often a best of three pull, the winner winning two out of the three pulls.


Name of the Event: Mini Cricket (Boys)



Name of the Event: Tug of War (Boys & Girls)


Sports club of MIET, organized Tug-of-war competition for boys and girls under track events on 19th & 20th December 2019 in Mangalmai Institute of Engineering and Technology. In this competition, two team(8 participants) at opposite ends of a rope, each team trying to drag the other across a centre line. In some forms of the game a tape or handkerchief is tied around the centre of the rope and two others are tied six feet (1.8 m) on either side. Three corresponding lines are marked on the ground. The competition ends when one participant's team pulls the other so that the tape on the losers' side crosses the ground mark on the winner's side. The contest is decided by the best two out of three pulls.

The rules of the event were as follows:

1. Each team in a Tug of War competition consists of eight people.
2. There are various weight classifications in Tug of War, and the mass of the eight people combined must not weigh more than that determined by the category that they are placed in.
3. The rope used should be of a circumference of approximately 11 cm and should be marked in the middle with a centre line as well as two marks that should be placed 4m from the centre line.
4. At the start of the pull, the centre line of the rope should be immediately above line marked on the ground.
5. Both teams pull the rope, the winner being the team who manage to pull the mark on the rope closest to their opponents over the centre line.
6. The rope must be pulled underarm and nobody's elbow must go below the knee, otherwise a foul will be called.
7. Matches are often a best of three pull, the winner winning two out of the three pulls.
8. The starter may give the commands in English or his own language.
9. Winners (1st and 2nd) will be announced.


Name of the Event: Mini Cricket (Boys)





Name of the Event: Badminton (Girls)




The rules of the event were as follows:





The rules of the event were as follows:

- Two teams face each other in this game (Team A and Team B)
- The game starts with toss between two team captain.
- The winning captain decides who will chase Team A or Team B.
- Both the team consists of 12 players.
- If Team A won the toss and decides to chase.
- 9 players from team A enters the playground.
- All 9 players sit/kneel in the middle of the court facing opposite direction in a straight row.
- A match consists of two innings of running and chasing turns of 9 minutes.
- From Team B, three players can enter the kho-kho ground as the runner.
- All 9 players of the team sit in a row with both the end having a pole.
- The 3 runners can go between two players of Team A who are sitting in a Zigzag alignment.

- He can only turn back and chase after he touches the pole at either end of the line.

The rules of the event were as follows:


1. Play the music and have the players walk around the perimeter of the chair circle.

5. Winner will be announced.




Name of the Event: Tug of War (Boys & Girls)


In the theme of AZADI KA AMRIT MAHOTSAV our sports club organized Tug-of-war competition for boys and girls were organized under track events on 14th & 15th December 2018 in Mangalmai Institute of Engineering and Technology. In this competition, two participant's team at opposite ends of a rope, each team trying to drag the other across a centre line. The competition ends when one participant's team pulls the other so that the tape on the losers' side crosses the ground mark on the winners' side. 1. Each team in a Tug of War competition consists of eight people.
2. There are various weight classifications in Tug of War, and the mass of the eight people combined must not weigh more than that determined by the category that they are placed in.
3. The rope used should be of a circumference of approximately 11 cm and should be marked in the middle with a centre line as well as two marks that should be placed 4m from the centre line.
4. At the start of the pull, the centre line of the rope should be immediately above line marked on the ground.
5. Both teams pull the rope, the winner being the team who manage to pull the mark on the rope closest to their opponents over the centre line.
6. The rope must be pulled underarm and nobody's elbow must go below the knee, otherwise a foul will be called.
7. Matches are often a best of three pull, the winner winning two out of the three pulls.
8. The starter may give the commands in English or his own language.
9. Winners (1st and 2nd) will be announced.




